


Due to safety concerns, Lear Construction will be barricading the sidewalk on the north side of 43rd Avenue, most likely for the remainder of the school year.



There are two access points into the construction site, which have become very rutted, pitted and muddy during the course of the construction project. For the safety of our students walking to school, and all pedestrians, Lear Construction will be placing barricades on this sidewalk, beginning on Monday, May 31, which will remain in place for the foreseeable future. This will impact students who walk to and from Chester Ronning School, as well as families who drop-off and pick-up students in the morning and afternoon.

Starting next week, students who walk will need to cross at the 62 Street Close crosswalk and use the sidewalk on the south side of 43rd Avenue. Parents who drive are encouraged to use the 62 Street Close as a drop-off point.

The Lear Construction Crew will now be parking on the north side of 43rd Avenue, providing additional space for families to park and drop-off/pick-up on the south side of the street, where the sidewalk remains open.
